Eligible Projects	Developing a comprehensive safety action plan or Action Plan (i.e., the activities in Table 1, as well as the supplemental planning and demonstration activities described in Section A.2); Conducting planning, design, and development activities for projects and strategies identified in an Action Plan; and carrying out projects and strategies identified in an Action Plan
