- No Cost to the user

B2Gnow Certification & Compliance System

(Business 2 Government)

- Online tool for applying for DBE certification & annual program eligibility review
- Required for DBE's since July 1, 2015
- Complete DBE Directory
- Correspondence with DBEs
- Future Utilization Plans for Prime Contractors

LCPtracker

(Labor Compliance Program Tracker)

- Online system used by contractors to electronically file and track Certified Payrolls under Davis Bacon and Related Acts.
- Ensures the correct prevailing wages are paid to covered workers.
- Ensures compliance with CFR requirements

Benefits of LCPtracker

- Paperless/eco-friendly
- Time saver
- All DBRA wages are uploaded in the system for you
- Payroll data entered directly through upload option
- All Certified payrolls in one place
- Systematic edit checks for errors
- Instant reports

What you need to do

- Prime Contractors / Consultants / Project Engineers / Project Managers – Contact Civil Rights Division get set up with account
- Contractors can use account from another State with same credentials
- Once you have an account, please start using the software and taking advantage of the training offered.
