



New Minor Drivers License Law Requirements effective January 1, 2012

Requirements as of January 1, 2012

- ◀ If under 16 years of age must hold an instruction permit for at least 12 months.
- ◀ If under the age of 16, must complete North Dakota Drivers Education Requirements.
- ◀ Permit holders under the age of 16 must accumulate a minimum of 50 hours supervised behind-the-wheel driving experience in various driving conditions.
- ◀ Drivers under the age of 16, cannot drive between 9 p.m. and 5 a.m. unless driving to or from work, school or religious activities, or if accompanied by an adult.

Other related driver laws

- ◀ No texting while driving for drivers of any age in North Dakota.
- ◀ Any driver under the age of 18 is prohibited from using electronic communication devices while driving.
