OVERVIEW

Asphalt Pavement Inspection is a course for individuals who are pursuing certification through the NDDOT Technical Certification Program (TCP) to work on QC/QA asphalt paving projects. Course length is approximately 24 hours.

This course will provide an overview of the asphalt paving process from material production to placement.

Successful completion of this course provides certification as an Asphalt Pavement Inspector which is a requirement for both Contractor (QC) and Engineer (QA) personnel during mix production. Individuals holding this certification are typically the contractor paving supervisor or the Engineer's inspector.

This course is open and encouraged for all construction professionals actively involved in asphalt pavement design, material production and all asphalt paving outside the scope of QC/QA. It is not an introductory course nor is it a general inspection training course.
