

Temporary License & Drive-Out Permits

I am from out-of-state working in North Dakota. How do I get a permit to work in your state?

Temporary license may be purchased by non-residents for a period of 6 or 12 months and must be displayed on the vehicle rear window on driver's side visible to law enforcement. Permits are available online, from law enforcement, or any Motor Vehicle Division office. Vehicle must also display valid registration and license plate from any jurisdiction and be properly insured.

What are the fees for a temporary license?

1. Passenger, pickups, vans, and trucks not exceeding 20,000 lbs are furnished a permit upon payment of the following fees: \$60 for 6 months or \$120 for 12 months, plus a \$10 permit fee.
2. Trucks or combinations of trucks and trailers requiring a registered gross weight of 22,000 lbs or greater are furnished a permit upon payment of the following fees, plus a \$10 permit fee:

Weight	Six - Month Fee	Twelve - Month Fee
20,001 - 42,000	\$220	\$440
42,001 - 62,000	\$380	\$760
62,001 - 82,000	\$530	\$1,060
82,001 - 105,500	\$900	\$1,800

3. Motorcycles are furnished a permit upon payment of \$30 for 6 months, or \$60 for 12 months, plus a \$10 permit fee.

I purchased a vehicle in North Dakota. How do I get it to my home state to register?

An out-of-state resident who purchases a vehicle in our state can obtain a Drive Out permit online at www.dot.nd.gov. The permit is valid for 30 days from date of issue, must be displayed in the window of the vehicle, and allows the individual to drive the vehicle from our state to their home of record state. The fee is \$5.
