



Governor's Dr / North Dakota 18 Shared Use Path

A shared use path is planned along Governor's Dr / North Dakota 18 from 37th Street SE to Cottonwood Dr. The path aims to answer a growing safety concern for pedestrians on the highway shoulder and connects the newly completed Prairie Skies Residential Subdivision to the rest of the City's amenities. The 10' wide path project will also include:

- Pedestrian bridge over Swan Creek
- Pedestrian highway crossing systems
 - Curb bumpouts
 - Crosswalk striping
 - RRFB signals
- Drainage culvert extensions

Questions & Answers:

When will construction happen?

Tentatively scheduled to start in the 2024 construction season. Based on environmental clearances and funding limitations, a portion of the project might occur in 2025.

Project Cost and Funding?

Current preliminary project estimate is \$2.1 Million.

Current grant funding is \$755,000. \$680,000 from the FHWA Carbon Reduction Program funding and \$75,000 from the Garrison Diversion Conservancy District Matching Recreation Grant. The City of Casselton is pursuing other grant opportunities.

How will the local share of the project be funded?

Currently the plan is to use special assessments to cover the local share of the project. Assessment philosophy and amounts to be determined further into the design process. The unsold lots within Prairie Skies and businesses within the project corridor are anticipated to be included in the assessment boundary.
