No Travel Advisory Lifted for Minot and surrounding areas I-94 from Mandan to Dickinson remains closed

The North Dakota Department of Transportation (NDDOT) and the North Dakota Highway Patrol have **LIFTED** the **No Travel Advisory** in Minot and surrounding areas but a Travel Alert will remain in effect.

Interstate-94 eastbound and westbound from Mandan to Dickinson are closed due to the roadway becoming blocked with heavy snow. In addition conditions include extreme ice, compacted snow and blowing and drifting snow causing long stretches of icy roads and near zero visibility at times creating hazardous driving conditions.

A No Travel Advisory is in effect for Bismarck, Mandan, and surrounding areas.

A Travel Alert is in effect for Williston, Dickinson, Valley City and surrounding areas.

Motorists should also be aware that travel conditions can change quickly and blowing and drifting snow with heavy accumulation throughout the night will continue to create hazardous driving conditions and roads could become blocked, especially at bridges or sheltered areas.
