No Travel Advisory extended to Williston and Jamestown areas

The North Dakota Department of Transportation (NDDOT) and the North Dakota Highway Patrol have extended the **No Travel Advisory** to include additional areas in northwestern and south central North Dakota due to strong winds, low visibility, blowing and drifting snow and compacted snow creating hazardous driving conditions. Cities included in the **No Travel Advisory** include Williston, Watford City, New Town, Crosby and surrounding areas in northwestern ND and Jamestown, Edgeley, Gackle, Medina and surrounding areas in south central ND. Conditions are such that motorists in this area **should not travel**.

Motorists should be aware the following advisories are still in effect:

- A **Travel Alert** is in effect for western and north central areas including Dickinson, Minot, Devils Lake and surrounding areas. Conditions are such that **motorists can still travel** in these areas, but should be advised of rapidly changing conditions. Motorists are encouraged to reduce speeds and drive according to the conditions.
- A **No Travel Advisory** is in effect for areas in south central ND including Bismarck/Mandan and surrounding areas.
