## Travel Alert extended to northwestern North Dakota

The North Dakota Department of Transportation (NDDOT) and the North Dakota Highway Patrol have extended a **Travel Alert** from south central North Dakota to also include portions of northwestern North Dakota due to reduced visibility and some areas of compacted snow or ice on roadways. The **Travel Alert for northwestern North Dakota** includes the cities of Williston, Tioga, Stanley, Bowbells, Crosby and surrounding areas. The **Travel Alert for portions of south central North Dakota** includes Bismarck, Mandan, Flasher, Linton and surrounding areas.

A **Travel Alert** means conditions are such that **motorists can still travel** in these areas, but should be advised of rapidly changing conditions. Motorists are encouraged to reduce speeds and drive according to the conditions.
