No Travel Advised in South Central North Dakota; Travel Alert extended to Western and North Central North Dakota

The North Dakota Department of Transportation (NDDOT) and the North Dakota Highway Patrol have issued a **No Travel Advised** in south central North Dakota including the cities of Bismarck, Glen Ullin, Selfridge, Steele and Underwood due to strong winds, low visibility, blowing and drifting snow and compacted snow creating hazardous driving conditions. Conditions are such that motorists in this area **should not travel**.

The **Travel Alert** has been extended to western and north central North Dakota including Dickinson, Minot, Devils Lake and surrounding areas.

A **Travel Alert** is still in effect for cities in northwestern North Dakota including the cities of Williston, New Town and Watford City and surrounding areas due to reduced visibility and some areas of compacted snow or ice on roadways. Conditions are such that **motorists can still travel** in these areas, but should be advised of rapidly changing conditions. Motorists are encouraged to reduce speeds and drive according to the conditions.

A **No Travel Advisory** is still in effect for Divide County in extreme northwestern North Dakota due to reduced visibility and icy roads creating hazardous driving conditions. Conditions are such that motorists in this area **should not travel**.
