Travel Alert extended to Watford City and New Town

The North Dakota Department of Transportation (NDDOT) and the North Dakota Highway Patrol have extended a **Travel Alert** in northwestern North Dakota to also include Watford City, New Town and surrounding areas due to reduced visibility and some areas of compacted snow or ice on roadways. The **Travel Alert** is still in effect for the cities of Williston, Tioga, Stanley, Bowbells, Crosby and surrounding areas and also **portions of south central North Dakota** including: Bismarck, Mandan, Flasher, Linton and surrounding areas.

A **No Travel Advisory** is also in effect for Divide County in extreme northwestern North Dakota due to reduced visibility and icy roads creating hazardous driving conditions. Conditions are such that motorists in this area **should not travel**.

A **Travel Alert** means conditions are such that **motorists can still travel** in these areas, but should be advised of rapidly changing conditions. Motorists are encouraged to reduce speeds and drive according to the conditions.
