## **I-94 OPEN from Bismarck to Jamestown No Travel Advisory remains in effect for areas east of Bismarck Travel Alert in effect for Jamestown, Valley City, Minot, Devils Lake, Grand Forks and areas west of Bismarck**

The North Dakota Department of Transportation (NDDOT) and the North Dakota Highway Patrol have **OPENED** eastbound and westbound I-94 from Bismarck to Jamestown.

A **No Travel Advisory** remains in effect for areas east of Bismarck due to strong winds, low visibility, blowing and drifting snow creating hazardous driving conditions.

A **Travel Alert** is in effect for Jamestown, Valley City, Minot, Devils Lake, Grand Forks, areas west of Bismarck and surrounding areas due to icy roads, visibility reduced down to 500 ft at times, and scattered snow drifts. Motorists are encouraged to reduce speeds and drive according to the conditions.
