## **No Travel Advised for areas in northwestern and north central North Dakota**

The North Dakota Department of Transportation (NDDOT) and the North Dakota Highway Patrol have issued a **No Travel Advisory** for portions of northwestern and north central North Dakota due to near zero visibility. Cities included in the No Travel Advisory are: Minot, Harvey, Bottineau, Crosby, Stanley, Bowbells, New Town and surrounding areas. Motorists in this area should **not travel** as blowing and drifting snow is creating hazardous driving conditions.

A **Travel Alert** remains in effect for Bismarck, Jamestown, Valley City, Devils Lake, Grand Forks, and surrounding areas. Motorists should slow down and drive according to conditions as there are still many areas in the state with severe snow drifts blocking roads and areas of low visibility.
