## **I-94 OPEN from Mandan to Dickinson; I-29 OPEN from Fargo to Canadian Border; US 2 OPEN from Devils Lake to Grand Forks Airport**

### **I-94 remains closed from Bismarck to Fargo**

**No Travel Advisory LIFTED for areas west of Bismarck, Williston, Minot, Devils Lake, Grand Forks and Fargo**

**No Travel Advisory remains in effect for areas east of Bismarck, Jamestown and Valley City**

**Travel Alert in effect for areas west of Bismarck, Dickinson, Minot, Devils Lake and Grand Forks**

The North Dakota Department of Transportation (NDDOT) and the North Dakota Highway Patrol have OPENED eastbound and westbound I-94 from Mandan to Dickinson. Northbound and southbound I-29 is OPEN Fargo to the Canadian border. Eastbound and westbound US Highway 2 is OPEN from Devils Lake to the Grand Forks Airport.

The **No Travel Advisory** has been lifted for areas west of Bismarck, Williston (except for Bowbells and Stanley areas), Minot, Devils Lake, Grand Forks and Fargo.

A **Travel Alert** is in effect for areas west of Bismarck, Dickinson, Minot, Devils Lake and Grand Forks due to icy roads, visibility reduced down to 500 ft at times, and scattered snow drifts. Motorists are encouraged to reduce speeds and drive according to the conditions.

#### **Motorists should be aware the following advisories are still in effect:**

- A **No Travel Advisory** remains in effect for areas east of Bismarck, Jamestown, Valley City, and surrounding areas due to strong winds, low visibility, blowing and drifting snow creating hazardous driving conditions.
- **I-94 CLOSED** from Bismarck to Fargo Conditions include extreme ice, compacted snow and blowing and drifting snow causing long stretches of icy roads and near zero visibility at times creating hazardous driving conditions.
