## **NDDOT seeks comments on 2017 Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (STIP) Amendment**

The North Dakota Department of Transportation (NDDOT) is seeking comments on an amendment to the 2017-2020 State Transportation Improvement Program (STIP) for inclusion of a previously-unpublished project in 2017 and for a change in the cost and scope of a previously-published project in 2017.

1. Turn Lanes on US Highway 2 from two miles east of Devils Lake continuing east for approximately three miles.  
Total Cost: \$850,000
2. Westbound paving was added to the eastbound project on US Highway 2 from approximately one mile west to one mile east of Rugby which increased the total cost for the project to \$1,200,000.
