## **NDDOT seeks comments on 2012 Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (STIP) Amendment**

The North Dakota Department of Transportation (NDDOT) is seeking comments on an amendment to the 2012-2015 State Transportation Improvement Program (STIP) for inclusion of the following previously-unpublished projects in 2013.

### Urban Projects:

1. Minot Burdick Expressway: 42<sup>nd</sup> Street to US Highway 2 – Milling and Hot Bituminous Overlay  
Total Cost: \$125,000
2. Minot 42<sup>nd</sup> Street SE: 11<sup>th</sup> Avenue SE to US Highway 2 – Milling and Hot Bituminous Overlay  
Total Cost: \$50,500

### State Projects:

1. ND Highway 13: Four miles west of the Junction of ND Highway 1 – Pipe Replacement and Slope Flattening  
Total Cost: \$245,000
2. Interstate 29: North of the Junction of ND Highway 66 to the Canadian Line, Southbound – Hot Bituminous Overlay, Concrete Pavement Repair, Concrete Pavement Replacement, Milling, Weigh in Motion, and Automatic Traffic Recorder  
Total Cost: \$17,200,000
3. ND Highway 5: Junction of I-29, Joliette, east to the Red River – Milling and Recycled Hot Bituminous Pavement  
Total Cost: \$550,000
4. US Highway 81: West Junction of ND Highway 5, Hamilton, east to the Junction of I-29 – Milling and Recycled Hot Bituminous Pavement  
Total Cost: \$1,100,000
5. Interstate 29: ND Highway 13/Mooreton Interchange, Westbound – Bridge Deck Replacement & Approach Slab Replacement  
Total Cost: \$1,000,000
6. ND Highway 13: Intersection Improvements and Turn Lanes near Milnor  
Total Cost: \$500,000
