Construction to start on ND Highway 22 and a segment will be closed from junction of ND 73 north of Mandaree to junction of ND 23

A construction project will start Thursday, April 11, on ND Highway 22 and a segment of the highway will be closed from the junction of ND Highway 73 north of Mandaree to the junction of ND Highway 23. Only local traffic will be allowed on this 14 mile segment of ND 22 during the construction project. Construction consists of complete reconstruction and widening of the roadway.

A signed detour will be in place during the closure:

- Northbound motorists take ND 73 west to ND 23. Follow ND 23 north and then east.
- Southbound motorists follow ND 23 west and then south to ND 73. Take ND 73 east to ND 22.

The project is expected to be completed in June.

Rear end crashes are the most common in work zones. Motorists are encouraged to slow down, allow extra distance between their vehicles and the vehicle in front of them, use caution and obey flaggers and posted signs.
