Construction project on US 2 in Ray to begin today

The first phase of a construction project begins today, April 10, on US Highway 2 through Ray. The first phase of the project includes working on underground utilities. The rest of the project work includes highway concrete overlay, paving and replacement of gutter and sidewalks.

During the project:

- Traffic on portions of US 2 through Ray will be redirected.
- Traffic will be reduced to one lane in each direction
- A width restriction of 10 feet will be in place.
- Speeds will be reduced

The project is expected to be completed this summer.

The traveling public should use caution when driving through the construction zone. Motorists should allow extra distance between their vehicles and the vehicles in front of them, slow down and obey flaggers and posted signs.
