Construction to begin April 15 on Highway 85 in Belfield

A construction project will begin Monday, April 15, on Highway 85, from Belfield to 12 miles south of Belfield. The project will include bridge work, slope protection guardrail work and bridge overlays in three different locations. Motorists are asked to use caution in the work zone as trucks will be entering and exiting the roadway.

During the project

- Flaggers will be present when needed
- Speeds will be reduced to 35 mph in work zones
- A width restriction of 13.5 ft. will be in place
- Stop lights will be placed in each of the work zones to handle traffic
- Delays should be minimal

The project is expected to be completed in June.

The traveling public should use caution when driving through the construction zone as workers may be present. Motorists should allow extra distance between their vehicles and the vehicles in front of them, slow down and obey flaggers and posted signs.
