Motorists advised to watch for water tonight on ND Highway 52, two miles southeast of US 2 near Minot

The North Dakota Department of Transportation (NDDOT) would like to alert motorists that overland flooding may cause water to be on ND Highway 52 tonight, approximately 2 miles southeast of the junction of US 2 near Minot. There is currently water up to the edge of the roadway but water levels may rise throughout the evening, causing water to rise onto the highway. Motorists are advised to slow down, watch for signs or flaggers and use caution, as vehicles that leave the roadway may become immersed in water.

Fluctuating water levels make it difficult to predict when and where water will go over a roadway or recede from the roadway. The NDDOT encourages motorists to check road conditions before traveling due to rapidly changing conditions. Please be advised that road condition information on 511 and the travel map is updated daily from 5 a.m. until 9 p.m. CDT. The road report is based upon the information available to the NDDOT at the time of preparation and is provided solely as a public service. Conditions may vary from those reported.
