Construction begins this week in Gwinner

Construction will begin this week on ND Hwy 13 in Gwinner. The project will consist of a sidewalk project, installations of ADA ramps and curb gutter replacement. The following week, work will continue between Gwinner and ND 1 with pipe replacements. Travelers should be ready for changing pavement conditions throughout the project.

During Construction

- Flaggers will control traffic through the work zone in Gwinner
- Speed will be reduced to 55 mph in the rural portion of the project with additional speed reductions between Gwinner and ND Hwy 1 as needed
- Gravel may be present on the roadway
- Work on the project also includes a mill and overlay at a later date

The project is expected to be complete by the end of October.

Rear end crashes are the most common in work zones. Motorists are encouraged to slow down, allow extra distance between their vehicles and the vehicle in front of them, use caution and obey flaggers and posted signs.
