## **ND Highway 5 and 18 in Cavalier now closed due to flood operations**

The North Dakota Department of Transportation (NDDOT) and the North Dakota Highway Patrol have closed ND Highway 5 and ND Highway 18 into Cavalier to allow city officials to conduct flood control operations. Only local traffic is allowed in the area.

**The following highways are affected by flood waters, but remain open to traffic, with traffic speeds reduced:**

- ND 32, five miles north of Mountain
- ND 18, one mile north of Forest River
- ND 66, traffic is reduced to one lane in the town of Crystal to allow city officials to conduct flood control operations
- ND 200, two miles east of Bowdon
- ND 200, westbound lane four miles west of Hurdsfield

Fluctuating water levels make it difficult to predict when and where water will go over a roadway or recede from the roadway. The NDDOT encourages motorists to check road conditions before traveling due to rapidly changing conditions. Please be advised that road condition information on 511 and the travel map is updated daily from 5 a.m. until 9 p.m. CDT.
