Construction begins on southbound I-29 from Canadian border to Drayton

Construction began this week on a concrete pavement repair project on the southbound roadway of I-29 from the Canadian border to Drayton.

During the work:

- Traffic will be reduced to one lane for segments throughout the work zone
- Speeds will be reduced
- Width restriction of 15 feet in place
- Flaggers may be present

The project is expected to be complete this fall.

Help prevent work zone crashes. Motorists are encouraged to slow down, allow extra distance between their vehicles and the vehicle in front of them, use caution and obey flaggers and posted signs.
