Construction begins this week on US Highway 2 west of Stanley

Work began today, July 15, on US Highway 2 west of Stanley. The project consists of adding turning lanes to the eastbound and westbound roadway beginning five miles west of the Tioga turn-off continuing to Stanley. Additional paving work will take place in the eastbound roadway from east of the Tioga turn-off to Stanley.

During construction:

- Eastbound and westbound roadways will be reduced to a single lane while work on the turn lanes is being conducted.
- Speeds will be reduced.
- Flaggers may be present.
- Oil may be present on the roadway during paving operations.

The project is expected to be complete in October.

Help prevent work zone crashes. Motorists are encouraged to slow down, allow extra distance between their vehicles and the vehicle in front of them, use caution and obey flaggers and posted signs.
