Public Input Meeting to be held on August 26, 2013, to discuss Proposed Improvements to ND Highway 40 From US Highway 2 to the Railroad Overpass in Tioga

A Public Input Meeting will be held from 5 p.m. to 7 p.m. on August 26, 2013, at the Tioga High School, 303 N. Linda Street, Tioga, North Dakota. The Public Input Meeting will utilize an open house format with a formal presentation at 5:30 p.m.

The purpose of the Public Input Meeting is to discuss proposed improvements for ND Highway 40 from the junction of US Highway 2 to the Railroad Overpass in Tioga. The Public Input Meeting will provide opportunity for public input. Representatives from the North Dakota Department of Transportation and Apex Engineering Group will be available to discuss the project and answer questions.
