Construction starts Monday on northbound I-29 at Pembina border crossing

Construction will start on Monday, August 19, on the northbound roadway of I-29 near the Pembina border crossing. Construction consists of adding an additional northbound driving lane at the border crossing.

During the work:

- Traffic will be reduced to one lane
- Speeds will be reduced
- A width restriction of 15 feet will be in place
- Flaggers may be present during certain construction activities

The project is expected to be complete in October 2013.

Help prevent work zone crashes. Motorists are encouraged to slow down, allow extra distance between their vehicles and the vehicle in front of them, use caution and obey flaggers and posted signs.
