**Public Information Meeting to be held on August 22, 2013 to discuss the proposed grade separation of US Highway 2/85 (West Dakota Parkway) at 18th Street W in Williston**

A Public Information Meeting will be held from 6 p.m. to 8 p.m. on Thursday August 22, 2013 at Williston High School Auditorium, 502 W. Highland Drive, Williston, ND. The Public Information Meeting will utilize an open house format with a formal presentation at 6:30 p.m.

The purpose of the Public Information Meeting is to discuss the proposed improvements in Williston, ND at the intersection of 18th Street W and US Highway 2/85. The City and the NDDOT have agreed on a project alternative for this intersection. The project chosen consists of an underpass of US Highway 2/85 from 18th Street W to Bison Drive. Affected intersections include:

- 18th Street W and Davidson Drive
- 18th Street W and Crest Street
- 18th Street W and US Highway 2/85
- Bison Drive and Frontage Road (west of US Highway 2/85)
- Bison Drive and 14th Avenue W
- Bison Drive and 16th Avenue W

The Public Information Meeting will provide opportunity for the public to ask questions. Representatives of City of Williston, NDDOT, and the SRF Consulting Group will be present.
