ND Highway 20 near Munich will be temporarily closed due to railroad crossing work

Railroad crossing construction projects will start Monday, September 9, on ND Highway 20 near Munich. Two segments of ND Highway 20 will be temporarily closed, one segment is at the Junction of ND Highway 20 and ND Highway 66 south of Munich and another segment is on ND 20 just north of Munich. Motorists need to take alternate routes. The project work will be done by Northern Plains Railroad.

- Work will start on Monday, September 9 and is expected to take about one week
- Motorists are encouraged to take alternate routes

Rear end crashes are the most common in work zones. Motorists are encouraged to slow down, allow extra distance between their vehicles and the vehicle in front of them, use caution and obey flaggers and posted signs.
