## **ND Highway 66 near Drayton will be reduced to one lane due to railroad crossing work**

A railroad crossing construction project will start Monday, September 16, at the south intersection of ND Highway 66 and ND Highway 81 west of Drayton. Traffic will be reduced to one lane and controlled by flaggers. Motorist can expect minimal delays.

- Work will start on Monday, September 16 and is expected to take a few days
- Flaggers will be present

Rear end crashes are the most common in work zones. Motorists are encouraged to slow down, allow extra distance between their vehicles and the vehicle in front of them, use caution and obey flagger and posted signs.
