## ***Public Input Meeting to be held on October 15, 2013 to discuss Proposed Improvements to 37th Avenue Southeast in Minot***

A Public Input Meeting will be held from 5:30 p.m. to 7:30 p.m. on Tuesday, October 15, 2013, at Minot City Hall in the Police Department Training Room at 515 2nd Ave SW in Minot, North Dakota. The Public Input Meeting will utilize an open house format.

The purpose of the Public Input Meeting is to discuss proposed improvements to 37th Avenue Southeast from South Broadway to 13th Street Southeast in Minot. The project consists of reconstructing 37th Avenue Southeast to create a paved roadway with center turn lane, construction of a shared-use path, and improvements to storm sewers, storm water detention facilities, water main and lighting. The Public Input Meeting will provide opportunity for public input. Representatives from the City of Minot, North Dakota Department of Transportation, and Kadrmars, Lee & Jackson (KLJ) will be on hand to answer questions and discuss concerns.
