Public Information Meeting to be held on November 18, to discuss proposed improvements to ND Highway 46 near Enderlin

A Public Information meeting will be held from 5 p.m. to 7 p.m. on November 18, 2013 at the Enderlin City Auditor's office. The Public Information Meeting will utilize an open house format with a formal presentation at 5:30 p.m.

The purpose of the Public Information meeting is to discuss proposed improvements for ND 46 from the junction of ND 32 to nine miles east of Enderlin. The meeting will provide opportunity for the public to ask questions. The North Dakota Department of Transportation (NDDOT) will be in attendance to answer questions.

The NDDOT will consider every request for reasonable accommodation to provide:

- an accessible meeting facility or other accommodation for people with disabilities,
- language interpretation for people with limited English proficiency (LEP), and
- translations of written material necessary to access NDDOT programs and information.
