Public Input Meeting to be held on December 5, 2013, to discuss Proposed Improvements to ND Highway 5 in Cavalier

A Public Input Meeting will be held from 5 to 7 p.m. on December 5, 2013, at the Cavalier City Hall, 301 Division Avenue North, Cavalier, ND 58220. The meeting will utilize an open house format.

The purpose of the Public Input Meeting is to discuss the proposed bank stabilization of the Tongue River along ND 5 from Island Place approximately 200 feet south. The meeting will provide opportunity for public input. Representatives from the NDDOT and Widseth Smith Nolting will be on hand to answer your questions and discuss your concerns.
