NDDOT seeks comments on 2014 Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (STIP) Amendment

The North Dakota Department of Transportation (NDDOT) is seeking comments on an amendment to the 2014-2017 State Transportation Improvement Program (STIP) for inclusion of the following previously-unpublished projects in 2014.

State Projects:

1. Signing improvements on the eastbound and westbound lanes of I-94 from the south junction of ND Highway 3, Dawson, to the junction of ND Highway 38.
Total Cost: \$500,000
2. Signing improvements on various state highways in southeastern North Dakota.
Total Cost: \$850,000
