## ND Highway 256 south of Canadian Border temporarily closed due to water over the roadway

The North Dakota Department of Transportation (NDDOT) along with the North Dakota Highway Patrol (NDHP) are reporting ND Hwy 256 is temporarily **CLOSED** approximately one half mile south of the Canadian Border (north of Antler) due to water over the roadway. Also traffic is allowed at reduced speeds on ND Hwy 256 approximately 2 miles south of Antler due to water on the roadway.

Fluctuating water levels make it difficult to predict when and where water will go over a roadway or recede from the roadway. The NDDOT encourages motorists to check road conditions before traveling due to rapidly changing conditions.
