First Street in Williston reopens to traffic today, August 12, as part of second phase of Williston Main Street project

Construction will begin on Wednesday, August 13, on Main Street from Second Street East to south of the East Broadway intersection in Williston. As part of the second phase of the Main Street Reconstruction project, First Street has reopened to traffic today, August 12. The Main Street Reconstruction project will include replacement of storm drains, sewer, water, sidewalks, landscaping and signal lights.

Additional information regarding this project will be released throughout the construction season.
