Speeds to be reduced on Williston Temporary Truck Reliever Route from 140th Ave NW to 143rd Ave NW next week

Beginning on Tuesday, August 19th, speeds will be reduced to 25 mph on the Williston Temporary Truck Reliever Route from 140th Avenue Northwest to 143rd Avenue Northwest to allow construction equipment to enter and exit the roadway. The 25 mph speed restriction will be in place until Tuesday, August 26th. This work is part of the permanent Williston Truck Reliever Route.

During construction:

- Motorists should expect delays
- Flaggers will be in place
- Motorists are advised to watch for trucks exiting and entering this roadway
