

## **Public Information Meeting to be held on September 11, to discuss proposed improvements to ND Highway 23 in New Town**

A Public Information Meeting will be held from 5 p.m. to 7 p.m. on September 11, 2014, at the New Town City Hall Auditorium, 103 Soo Place, New Town, ND. The meeting will utilize an open house format with a formal presentation at 5:30 p.m.

The purpose of the Public Information Meeting is to discuss proposed improvements to ND Highway 23 from the junction of East Avenue to approximately 1,300 feet east of the junction with the New Town Northeast Truck Reliever Route (TRR). The project consists of a major rehabilitation strategy and may include widening to accommodate a three-lane roadway section, traffic signal installation, and installation of continuous lighting. The meeting will provide opportunity for the public to ask questions. Representatives from the NDDOT and SRF Consulting Group, Inc. will be on hand to answer your questions and discuss your concerns.

The North Dakota Department of Transportation (NDDOT) will consider every request for reasonable accommodation to provide:

- an accessible meeting facility or other accommodation for people with disabilities,
- language interpretation for people with limited English proficiency (LEP), and
- translations of written material necessary to access NDDOT programs and information.
