Traffic to be temporarily reduced to one lane tonight at the ND Highway 23 and ND Highway 1804 intersection in New Town

Traffic will be temporarily reduced to one lane from the intersection of ND Highway 23 and ND Highway 1804 to half a mile west on ND Highway 23 in New Town beginning at 7 p.m. this evening. During the closure crews will be working to pave the westbound lane of ND Highway 23. This project includes reconstruction of this intersection, paving, new intersection signals and an additional center turn lane on ND Highway 1804. The lane restriction is expected to be removed at 3 a.m. on Tuesday, September 9.

During construction:

- Speeds will be reduced to 25 mph
- Motorists should expect delays
- Flaggers will be in place
- A 11-foot width restriction will be in place
