Traffic switched to adjacent lanes at intersection of ND Highway 23 and ND Highway 1806 in Watford City

Traffic has been moved from a temporary detour to an adjacent northbound newly paved lane on ND Highway 1806 in Watford City at the intersection of ND Highway 23 and ND Highway 1806.

Traffic is rerouted and remains head to head so crews can continue paving work in the area. Traffic is reduced to one lane in each direction. This work is part of the Watford City Southeast Bypass project.

During construction:

- Traffic is head to head
- Speeds are reduced to 25 mph
- Motorists should expect delays
- Flaggers will be in place as needed
- A 12-foot width restriction is in place

The lane restriction will be removed in late October.
