Traffic to be shifted onto shoulders of ND Highway 23 east of Watford City beginning Monday, May 11

Beginning Monday, May 11, traffic will be shifted onto the shoulders of ND Highway 23 east of Watford City from the 122nd Ave NW intersection to the ND Highway 73 intersection (Johnson's Corner) to allow crews to perform milling work. Motorists should use caution when traveling through the area.

During construction:

- Motorists should expect delays
- Flaggers will be in place
- Speeds will be reduced to 25 mph
- A 12-foot width restriction will be in place
- Traffic will be head-to-head in some areas

Traffic will be rerouted on this portion of ND Highway 23 until August.
