## **ND Highway 23 lane shift east of Watford City to begin at 6 p.m. on Sunday, June 14**

Beginning at 6 p.m. on Sunday, June 14, eastbound traffic will be shifted onto the south shoulder of ND Highway 23 east of Watford City from the 122nd Ave NW intersection to the 116<sup>th</sup> Ave NW intersection. Westbound traffic will be shifted to the eastbound lane. The westbound lane will be closed to allow crews to prepare for paving work. Motorists should use caution when traveling through the area.

During construction:

- Motorists should expect delays
- Flaggers will be in place
- Speeds will be reduced to 25 mph
- A 12-foot width restriction will be in place
- Traffic will be head-to-head in some areas

Various traffic restrictions will be in place on this portion of ND Highway 23 throughout the construction season.
