Williston Northwest Permanent Truck Reliever Route two lane opening rescheduled to Saturday, June 13

Beginning on Saturday, June 13, two lanes of the Williston Northwest Truck Reliever Route will open to traffic for approximately seven miles from the junction of US Highway 2/85 north to County Road 6. Traffic will be head to head as crews will be continuing work on the southbound lanes of the Williston Northwest Truck Reliever Route. This opening was originally scheduled for today, Friday, June 12.

During construction:

- Motorists should expect delays
- Traffic will be head to head
- Flaggers will be in place at times
- Speeds will be reduced to 55 mph

Work on the southbound lanes of the Williston Northwest Permanent Truck Reliever Route is expected to be complete in August.
