A portion of the Williston Temporary Truck Reliever Route to temporarily close beginning Sunday, June 21

Beginning on Sunday, June 21, a portion of the Williston Temporary Truck Reliever Route will temporarily close to allow crews to perform paving and grading work on the Williston Northwest Permanent Truck Reliever Route. The 4.3 mile temporary closure extends from the intersection of the Williston Temporary Truck Reliever Route and US Highway 2/85 by Love's Travel Stop north of Williston to the intersection of 140th Avenue Northwest. East and westbound detours will be in place during the project.

During construction:

- Eastbound traffic will travel south on County Road 7 before turning east on 58th Street Northwest and continuing on US Highway 2/85
- Westbound traffic will turn west at 58th Street Northwest and then north on County Road 7 before merging back onto the Williston Temporary Truck Reliever Route
- Flaggers will be in place at times
- Speeds will be reduced to 45 mph
- Motorists should expect delays

The detour route will be in place through August.

The NDDOT Williston District serves the transportation needs of the communities in northwestern North Dakota, including Williston, Alexander, Watford City, New Town, Stanley, and Berthold. NDDOT has been working very hard to build new bypasses, expand roadways, and provide roadway improvements to enhance traffic movement.
