ND Highway 1804 to be reduced to one lane from south of Trenton to the US 2 intersection starting tomorrow, June 30

Starting tomorrow, Tuesday, June 30, ND Highway 1804 will be reduced to one lane of traffic in various locations from approximately 3 miles south of Trenton to the US Highway 2 intersection. Construction work will include crews performing chip seal work. A pilot car will be in place to direct traffic and motorists will take turns traveling through the area.

During construction:

- Speeds will be reduced in some areas
- Oil and gravel may be present on the roadway
- Motorists should expect delays

The lane restriction will be removed on Thursday, July 2.
