## **Traffic signals temporarily set to flash at US 2/Williston Northwest Truck Reliever Route intersection on Saturday**

On Saturday, October 3, the traffic signals at the US Highway 2 and the Williston Northwest Permanent Truck Reliever Route intersection near Love's Travel Stop will be set to flash beginning at 9 a.m. to allow crews to continue installing new traffic signals. This work is part of the Williston Northwest Permanent Truck Reliever Route. Flaggers will be in the area to facilitate traffic movement. Motorists are asked to use caution in the area.

During traffic signal work:

- Speeds will be reduced to 25 mph in the area at times.

The traffic signals will resume normal operation at approximately 5 p.m. on Saturday, October 3.
