## **Public Input Meeting to be held on February 3 to discuss proposed improvements to ND Highway 21 near Flasher**

A Public Input Meeting will be held from 5 to 7 p.m. on February 3, 2015, at the Flasher School located at 206 3rd Avenue East. The meeting will utilize an open house format.

The purpose of the Public Input Meeting is to discuss proposed improvements for ND Highway 21 from the junction of ND Highway 31 east to the junction of ND Highway 6. The meeting will provide opportunity for public input. Consultant engineers and representatives from the NDDOT will be in attendance.
