## **Public Input Meeting to be held on February 3 to discuss proposed improvements to ND Highway 200 near Killdeer**

A Public Input Meeting will be held from 5 to 7 p.m. (MDT) on Tuesday, February 3, 2015, at the Dunn Center City Hall. The meeting will utilize an open house format with a formal presentation at 5:30 p.m.

The purpose of the meeting is to discuss proposed roadway improvements to ND Highway 200 from Killdeer to the south junction of ND Highway 8. The meeting will provide opportunity for public input. Representatives from the NDDOT will be on hand to answer questions and discuss concerns.
