Public Input Meeting to be held on March 5, to discuss proposed improvements to ND Highway 20 near Jamestown

A Public Input Meeting will be held on March 5, 2015, from 5:30 to 7:30 p.m. at the Gladstone Inn & Suites, 11 Second Street Northeast, in Jamestown (in the Gladstone 3 Room). The meeting will utilize an open house format.

The purpose of the Public Input Meeting is to discuss proposed improvements for ND 20 from the Jamestown urban limits extending north 21.3 miles. The meeting will provide opportunity for public input. Staff from NDDOT and Stanley Consultants will be present to provide project information and answer questions.
