## Seasonal load restrictions will go into effect on some North Dakota state highways March 10

Seasonal load restriction will be placed on some North Dakota state highways on Tuesday, March 10. Seasonal load restrictions will be placed on North Dakota state highways this spring. The North Dakota Department of Transportation (NDDOT) normally places load restrictions on some state highways from March to May, depending on weather.

Motorists are encouraged to check the load restriction map daily as restrictions may change quickly due to weather.

To view the proposed Load Restriction Map, select Load Restrictions (Proposed) box on the left hand legend of the map. The highways with restricted legal load limits (solid green on the color map), as well as all other restricted highways, will require ton-mile fees when non-reducible loads exceed restricted weight limits.
