ND Highway 15 temporarily closed from ND 20 to ND 1 due to potential flooding

The North Dakota Department of Transportation (NDDOT) and the North Dakota Highway Patrol have temporarily closed ND Highway 15 from the junction of ND Highway 20 to ND Highway 1. The closure is due to the potential of flooding three miles west of Pekin. Motorists must use an alternate route. Local traffic may access Tolna from ND Highway 20.

The NDDOT encourages motorists to check road conditions before traveling due to rapidly changing conditions. For updated road information, call 511 from any type of phone or go to the Travel Information Map on our website at www.dot.nd.gov.

Road closed signs and barricades are placed on roads and bridges for the safety of the traveling public. It is against the law to drive past a road closure device on a closed road.
